Quite a Boast

When I was looking for a theological college at which to train for the ministry in the 1980s I considered two. At Lincoln the prospectus intriguingly noted that 'there are people in this diocese still alive who were confirmed by Bishop Edward King. Bishop King who had died 70 years previously was indeed a saintly figure of whom many touching anecdotes are told. At a time when bishops were often remote authority figures he was clearly humble and approachable.

Chichester considered it quite a boast that the college had never produced a bishop but supplied the church with a steady procession of solid faithful parish priests. It was to Chichester that I went!

One of these who trained there in the 1890s became the radical Communist flag waving vicar of Thaxted in Essex. Conrad Noel was a colourful character who like us at Rusper welcomed Morris dancers into his church.

Rather more sombrely we were reminded each year in September of a former Cicestrian Fr Vivian Redlich. He had gone as a missionary priest to Papua New Guinea where in 1942 he and his nurse fiancé May Hayman were caught up in the Japanese invasion. At a service in the college Chapel annually on September 2nd an account of his final hours written by an eyewitness were read out. He was preparing to celebrate the Sunday Eucharist when a message was brought to him warning him that the Japanese had been alerted to his presence. He stated his intention to remain at his post however, in order to celebrate the sacrament for his congregation. It seems he was unaware that May had already been captured and killed since following Mass he set off on his way to find and rescue her but was ambushed and beheaded by local tribesmen.

Also caught up in those dark days was the Bishop of Singapore who was tortured in prison. He later became Bishop of Birmingham. I was at school with the grandson of this very same Bishop Leonard Wilson, his mother, the bishop's daughter Susan Cole-King was an inspiring pioneer woman priest involved in the early days of the campaign for women's ordination in the Church of England. It is the faith of the church experience in every age that light

overcomes darkness and I like to imagine the saints as cat's eyes in the road reflecting that light to guide our journey.

A clause of the creed is that we believe in the Communion of Saints. Some of these holy characters may seem distant in time and experience from us but not all of them, by any means were priests let alone bishops. The phrase communion of Saints is synonymous with Holy Communion in which act of worship we are all equals in the sight of God.

Summary of Rusper Parish Council meeting & Planning Committee meeting – July 2022

Agreed responses to the following planning applications DC/22/0815 Furry Friends Freedom Field Prestwood Lane It was RESOLVED that there was no need to add any additional comments on this application following the Rusper Parish Council comments made on 17th May 2022.

DC/22/1087 Land West of Prestwood Lane

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council strongly objects to the application as it is not supported by the Rusper Neighbourhood Plan which identifies the area as a remote rural area unsuitable for development with no public transport or local amenities. It is also far from the nearest built up boundary, on a narrow lane that is considered unsuitable for the extra traffic entering and exiting the site on a blind bend. A development in this remote location is bound to have light impact contrary to the Rusper Neighbourhood Plan Dark skies policy. There are additional concerns based on the environmental damage to the Arun Valley due to water usage and the impact on the local wildlife site of Orltons Copse.

DC/22/1239 Topham Farm Rusper Road Newdigate

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows; Rusper Parish Council does not object to this application.

DC/22/1279 Land South of the Mount Farm The Mount Ifield

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows; The Rusper Parish Council does not object to this application, provided a condition is applied that this is for private and non-commercial fishing only.

DISC/22/0081 Quincefold Horsham Road Horsham

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows; The Rusper Parish Council would need extra information before decision. Specifically, the source of the tanked water as the Rusper Parish Council would be concerned if the water was sourced from the Arun Valley crisis area.

DC/22/1139 4 Charman Gardens Ifield Crawley

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows; Rusper Parish Council does not object to this application.

DC/22/1201Deerview Barn Waterfall Farm Prestwood Lane Ifield

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows; Rusper Parish Council objects to this application as planning permission was not sought within the 28 days of the change of use. In addition, there has been no option to assess the impact of the water use or mitigation of the use in respect of the Arun Valley crisis. The Rusper Parish Council requires clarity as to whether the 'annex' property is separate to the hotel opposite. If the annex is not separate any change should be considered for use as an annex to the main property opposite.

DC/22/1262 2 Old Park Cottages Bonnetts Lane Ifield

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows; Rusper Parish Council will withhold comment until a review of neighbours comments are available.

DC/22/1026 Land parcel 519268 133518 Winfield Road Faygate

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows; Rusper Parish Council objects to the application of the grounds that in spite of the rainwater harvesting plan, the water used either comes from the Arun, or is water that would have flowed into Chennells Brook and out to the Arun which risks increasing the current environmental crisis in the Arun Valley. The Rusper Parish Council have no other objections to the sports provision but agrees with the Highways statements with regard to shared foot and cycle paths and is concerned over the lack of car parking for a provision of this scale. The Rusper Parish Council would need assurance that any floodlighting has restricted use in accordance with the RPC dark skies policy.

The Full Council Meeting took place on the 26th July It was NOTED that Chris Hill had resigned with immediate effect. Cllr Kitchen reported as follows;

- A letter has been sent to all Councillors in respect of alleged airport parking on Bonnets Lane. On inspection of google map there appears to be evidence of a chalk racetrack in the same area. The issue has been passed to Planning Enforcement for review.
- There has been no further news in respect on the local plan.
 Further updates are not expected until after the results of the water neutrality issue have been reported in September.
- HDC have responded to the Gatwick Consultation on the Northern runway.

Cllr Nagel reported as follows;

- WSCC Highways are short staffed at present and items are taking longer than normal to be actioned.
- A road safety audit is being commissioned across all West Sussex to make it easier to implement traffic calming measures, this includes 30 mph zones and traffic calming measures.
- WSCC are opening a consultation in September specifically to identify highway hot spots.
- The Gatwick public consultation deadline has been extended until Q1 2024.
- The northern runway subgroup is reviewing Gatwick charging structures including the environmental impact of specific airport types in relation to noise, emissions and scheduling.

Rusper Highways Issues

Cllrs V. Hanstad-Pilcher and G. Hussey met with Alan Bazley, leader of the Highways group to inspect traffic issues around Rusper. Mr Bazley agreed a list of actions, including remarking the lines in the centre of the village and the commissioning of a study to identify the traffic hot spots around Rusper. Cllr V. Hanstad-Pilcher reported that the speed watch group would be reinvigorated, and the SID would remain in its current position until the results of the traffic hot spot study are known.

Rusper Conservation Consultation

It was RESOLVED the Cllr Sallows to completion the questionnaire on behalf of the council by the deadline of the 17th August.

Issues with Cyclist Behaviour

It was RESOLVED that the issues raised of in respect of the cyclist antisocial behaviour would be passed to Cllr Nagel.

It was RESOLVED that Forest Green Parish Council would be contacted to understand the level of alleged anti social behaviour of cyclists in their area and the remedies.

Reports from representatives

Councillors updated as follows:-

- Cllr G Flemning reported cleaning both the inside and out of the telephone box near the Lamb public house.
- Cllr F Maitland-Smith reported on a proposal for a volunteer litter pick and road sign cleaning.
 - **It was RESOLVED** to add the volunteer proposal to the August meeting agenda.
- Cllr Sallows reported that the Sports Club had a quote for the carrying out of the Legionella survey.
 - **It was RESOLVED** that Cllr Sallows would report to the Parish Council on the progress of Legionnaire testing.
 - **It was RESOLVED** to source a set of Terms of Reference for the future operational relationship between the Parish Council and the Sports Club.
- Cllr Sallows reported that the wall adjacent to the playground had now been rebuilt.
- Cllr Hussey reported on the meeting with SALC and specifically on resilience planning and the arrangements for Operation London Bridge.

The next planning meeting is on 16th August at 7.30 pm and the full council meeting on 30th August at 7.30pm both in the Rusper Village Hall.


