Mark My Footsteps

Throughout this past year in the Parish News I've taken my own personal, perhaps slightly quirky look at the Saints of Sussex. For me this series of reflections would not be complete without some reference to the Reverend John Mason Neale. He was one of those polymaths who seem to squeeze into a single short span of years the achievements of more than one lifetime. Neale who never knew robust health was only forty-eight When he died in 1866. His enduring legacy includes a worldwide community of a religious order of nuns which for most of its history had a Mother House at East Grinstead. He was a visionary for social care based on the Gospel, as well as a prodigious translator of writings from the early church including hymns in ancient languages. Surely his own composition the Christmas carol *Good King Wenceslas* is one of the best known and much loved in the genre, with a rollicking tune and a great story.

While carols sometimes evoke a misty glow and soft focus, Neale's offering belongs firmly in 2022 and the harsh reality of fuel poverty for many in the Britain of Johnson/Truss/Sunak*

Set on St Stephen's Day 26th December the description 'In his master's steps he trod' fits not only the story of the first Christian martyr but is an aspiration for all on the path of following Jesus.

Wenceslas was a historic figure, a devout Christian martyred by order of his own jealous brother. Historic record does indeed confirm that known for deeds of charity, Wenceslas, Duke of Bohemia [not King, Neale took a liberty there!] had a page and we know his name was Podiven and that his deep mourning following the death of his beloved master so enraged the brother that he had him killed too. Some commentators wonder if there was a deeper attachment between the two men. I like to think courageous Neale would not have been offended at such a possibility, and that if so, this carol carries modern messages of hope that cross man-made artificial boundaries. May it invite us to join hands and dance our step to the music of the heavenly spheres.

RUSPER CHRONICLE

Rusper Village Hall has served Rusper and its families since 1909 – for family celebrations, parties and dances, home to many village organisations, fundraising events and a long-standing relationship with Rusper School. Neil Mathewson wrote an excellent history of the hall in 2009 for the centenary which can be read online. Our plan at our November meeting, though defeated by the atrocious weather on the night, was to get personal memories. One member emailed to say he had met his lovely wife at the Youth Club in the 1960s and never regretted it - and we saw lovely photos of their wedding reception in the hall.

The origins of the hall probably go back to the 1880s when Bertha Broadwood from Lyne House set up a men's reading room in a cottage next to the shop – was that to keep them out of the newly opened beer houses? In 1909 the village hall (now the small hall and snooker room) was built together with a miniature rifle range (now serving as storage for the playgroup.) Important to state that it was a Men's Club – though women and children were allowed in for special events! The building of the main hall in 1929, the generous gift of Mr and Mrs Holroyd of Rusper House made many more activities possible, including drama productions and dances and enabled the hall to play its part in WW11 in providing a canteen for troops stationed in the area.

Our December meeting on Tuesday 13th December, 7-9 in the main hall, will finally introduce us to Rusper's dinosaurs – though I for one am glad I shan't meet one roaming the woods! And we shall celebrate with wine and mince pies. Do come and join us – everyone is welcome.

Planning - 18th Oct 2022

Agree responses to the following planning applications

DC/22/1918 Hillybarn Farmhouse. The Mount Ifield Crawley RH11 0LF

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: Rusper Parish Council STRONGLY objects to this application and should officers be minded to permit it, then RPC would call for it to go to full Council for consideration. RPC would also register their right to speak if it does go to Council.

DISC/22/0287 11/12 East Street RH12 4RB

It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows:

- The planning application, DC/19/1690, expires on 12/12/2022.
- Rusper Parish Council has no objection neutral However, given the current Environmental Emergency declared by Natural England, as work has not commenced on this application, the issues of water neutrality need to be addressed. The proposed re-routing of the main sewer behind the dwelling also highlights the extra waste water that will be added to the already stressed River Mole network that is prone to flooding. RPC suggests that these issues need to be considered before signing off this development.

DC/22/1770 Bella Vista Ashmore Lane Rusper Horsham RH12 4PS It was RESOLVED to comment on this application as follows: There seems to be no reason for RPC to comment on this application - the site is down a non-adopted road with no real impact on the general street view.

Council Meeting 25th Oct 2022

- Report from Rural Police Officer (Erica Baxter)
 Erica Baxter gave a report on the rural crime in Sussex and covered the four categories that make up rural crime: agriculture, equine, wildlife and heritage as well as environmental crime, which covers illegal waste dumping, fly tipping, polluting watercourses and land.
- **Co-option of a new Councillor -** Simon White has been co-opted as a Councillor of Rusper Parish Council.
- Terms of Reference for the collaboration between Rusper Parish and Save West of Ifield
 It was RESOLVED to approve the Terms of Reference Terms for the collaboration between Rusper Parish and Save West of Ifield.
- Expenditure for a Landscape Assessment £7,000 expenditure was approved in principle for a landscape consultant
- Revised Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group will be reformed

Update from HDC – Clir Kitchen gave a brief report: the cost of living crisis was the main topic at HDC with food banks getting used more and the donations diminishing; HDC's Local Plan may be available in November with the reminder that the district council elections were in May; water neutrality remains an issue

Reports from representatives

- Cllr Fleming cleaned and reorganised the phone box library
- Cllrs Gatt and Saunders will be attending the North Horsham liaison meeting on 27 October when they would again raise the question of traffic calming at the Mowbray development
- Cllr Sallows reported that the Sports field and pavilion were being used weekly and bins are now repaired; a deterrent was needed to prevent cars parking on the verge outside the sports field; the trees for the Queen's Canopy would be planted on 13 November; Rusper Stores were looking to have a semi-permanent large umbrella to cover the outside seating area. Rusper Stores should check with HDC concerning planning requirements as it is in the Rusper conservation area.
- Cllr Cooke reported that she had attended a Horsham District Old People's Forum where Cllr Jonathan Chowen spoke and a report would be circulated shortly; Cllr Cooke also attended a Climate Action Day at HDC offices and that the links to the documentation would be circulated when they had been received.
- Cllr Hanstad-Pilcher reported that: the SID would be moved on the 26 October to Faygate Lane; he was still waiting for the report from Highways who had done a survey of the Parish looking at road safety, pot holes etc. The RPC Roads Group are currently awaiting Highways input
- Cllr Hussey reported that the spring on the gate to the playground had been replaced; he also stated that he would be absent from Parish Council for a few weeks;

Clerk's report

- there would a locum clerk for the November meeting;
- a wreath had been purchased for the Remembrance Sunday service on the 13 November;
- the Order of Services booklets had been ordered for St Mary's.

SAVE WEST OF IFIELD

Save West of Ifield campaign

I hope most people are already aware, but Horsham District Council have announced dates for discussion of their Local Plan. If you are unhappy about the prospect of 10,000 houses and a bypass from Faygate across Lambs Green through to Ifield Wood, then now is the time to start writing to Horsham District Council (HDC). Key dates

- A. **Local Plan published** probably 8th December and almost certainly including at least phase 1 of the development, ie 3,000 houses.
- B. **HDC Cabinet meeting** to agree Plan should go forward to Full Council 15th December.
- C. **Full Council meeting** to agree Plan should go to public consultation ahead of submission to the Planning Inspector 11th January.

What can we do?

Write to HDC Cabinet, copying in HDC Planning Dept (addresses below) to tell them you object to the West of Ifield site being included in the Local Plan and why. This letter or email should arrive at the latest by 14th December and must include your name and address. If you need inspiration on what to say or to see what others have done, please see our Objections Page: https://www.savewestofifield.co.uk/objections

Save this letter – it could be useful again in January for the public consultation.
